On Tuesday night, March 10, 2009 Sheriff Michael A. Savokinas announces the following arrests were made by the Luzerne County Sheriff's C.O.B.R.A UNIT and Local Police. Assisting the C.O.B.R.A UNIT was Dupont Police Department, Avoca Police Department, and Hughestown Police Department and K-9. The following were arrested at the Petro Truck Plaza in Dupont. Amy CALLAHAN (32) of Avoca on outstanding charges of Prostitution, Loitering/ Prowling, Poss. Drug Paraphernalia, Failure to appear for a Preliminary Hearing and Failure to appear for Call of the List. CALLAHAN was also arrested on new charges of 2 Counts Poss. with intent to use Drug Paraphernalia, 5 counts Poss. with intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance, 1 count Poss. of a Controlled or Counterfeit Substance, 2 counts Default in Required Appearances. Joshua BOBECK (29) of Edwardsville on an outstanding Probation Warrant for original charges of DUI. BOBECK was also arrested on new charges of False I.D to Law Enforcement. Michael DEZINSKI (41) of Plains was arrested on new charges of 1 count Defiant Trespass, 2 counts Poss. with intent to use Drug Paraphernalia, 5 counts Poss. with intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance. All individuals were lodged at the Luzerne County Correctional Facility awaiting hearings. CALLAHAN and DEZINSKI are also being held on \$10,000.00 cash bail for their new charges.
